



Industry Insiders (e.g. a TSMC Representative)


Unique industrial insight and the possibility of wider engagement.

This will be difficult, given the potential for ROC representation, but with external society help not impossible.


CONFERENCE IDEA

STRATEGY: EXPLORING DIFFERENT CHANNELS, SIMULTANEOUSLY.

Some people simply do not have the time. Or else they may not care. Should that stop us from having a great range of speakers? NO!

In recognition of the fact that the World is not perfect (why else should we ever need so much IR?), we will focus on event topics, rather than speakers. This is the methodology I've followed in my earlier documentary work, and one which yielded much efficiency. It is also why subcommittee members, or others who may join me in this work, will be so integral to our work; with each member responsible for one of the connections, we can avoid a single point of failure.



GENERAL STRATEGY

- Online-focus to increase probability of attendance.
 - o in-person events more likely to materialise with returning speakers.
- Assign List of Names/persons/organisations to myself & each subcommittee member to focus on
- Bombardment of emails & cold calls through all existing channels; but with a schedule & with much patience.
- Where easiest, leverage family contacts.
- keep initial email short; there is no point lamenting for pages if they will not respond. However research & attempt every channel of inquiry.
- "Quantity over quality" in the initial instance, then careful & focused approach.




LEADING, BY BEING LEAD.

I like a vertical modal of leadership, where each subcommittee member (if there would be any, I would appreciate some clarification on this) including myself, would have tasks to do, which we would discuss together.. I've found this to be the most productive and least fractious mode of leadership in past experience.
